It includes general theoretical study I (The judicial organization and specialization, also the curriculum deals with comparative study in depth in one of accurate specialized subject like, suit theory (elements of judicial demand, judge authority ,litigant to these elements.

- Judgment theory (causing decisions, ways of appeal
- Arbitration (development and effect of modern electronic ways in practicing measures of exchanging memos and deliberations, and the legal problems resulting from it).

It includes theoretical and practical sides. The theoretical side includes: Law concept-roles of comparison between the different legislations and also transitions of legal regulations

COURSE DESCRIPTION**250-511: CONSTITUTIONAL LAW IN DEPTH
CR: 3**

It includes in depth study of one of constitutional law subjects, which includes The State and Regime relationship between public authority in The State

and the mutual censorship with the essential elements for Kuwaiti society and Authority relationship with citizens.

**250-513: CRIMINAL LAW IN DEPTH
CR: 3**

The curriculum deals with study in depth for the most prominent crimes as political or economic crimes, The curriculum is divided into two parts: The subjective terms for these crimes from where its elements and the decided penalty. And the second is the criminal judgments of these crimes from where investigation side litigation and penalty execution.

**250-514: PUBLIC FUNDS IN DEPTH
CR: 3**

Study in depth for the dominant rules for philosophy of public budget of The State from the financial, economic and constitutional basics and the related basics to budget principle of annual budget and exceptions of this principle from where its philosophy and justifications, also exposing in depth to independent and attached ones, studying principle of commonness of budget including two ideas of comprehensiveness and no specification for public funds, principle of budget balance from where idea basis, philosophy and practical applications.

**250-515: INTERNATIONAL LAW IN DEPTH
CR: 3**

The curriculum deals with the legal regime which controls the International relations among International public law (Countries & International institutions), It includes study in depth regarding role of International system elements as (The International legal character & the judicial immunity of The State), Problems of international relations (International institutions-International liability civil or criminal or diplomatic-Regional & International institutions-International Judicial authorities like (International Court of Justice) and specialized International Courts.

**250-516: ADMINISTRATIVE AND POLITICAL SYSTEMS IN ISLAM
CR: 3**

Study in depth for system of Authority in Islam: It starts with illustrating principles and rules of Islam Shariaa for clarifying Authority Theory in Islam specially what is already have a relation with public Authority in The Islamic State, on the basis of illustrating presidency in The Islamic State, sources of legislations in it, The Executive Power in The Islamic system, from where the administrative control in The Islamic Shariaa, basics and principles of administration in The Islamic State, At last The Judicial Authority in the Islamic system, Identifying conditions of jurisdiction and justice destination.

**250-517: ENVIRONMENTAL LAW
CR: 3**

Environment Law curriculum clarifies study in depth about laying down the main measures and aims related to protecting environment and role of public authorities in protecting it via identifying the environmental rights and its relation with human rights, development of protecting and concentrating on studying the administrative protection for the environment via explaining role of the administration in protecting the environment through position of administrative verification and identifying roles of the administrative liability regarding harms resulted from environment pollution.

**250-518: ADMINISTRATIVE LAW IN DEPTH
CR: 3**

The administrative law curriculum in depth is a study dealing with principles of the administrative regulation both, traditional and contemporary according to concept of electronic government system, The administrative activity including the administrative control and public utility, public position, the administrative contracts. The study in depth also includes the constitutional basics for the administrative systems and censorship & liability.

**250-519: TAX LEGISLATION

Study in depth for tax legislation requires research in philosophy of tax legislation and its development and comparing taxes with obligatory financial deduction in Islamic legislation as zakah, tribute and the other financial Islamic deduction.

Also study in depth for taxes legislation which studying taxes legislations in State of Kuwait and settling taxes disputes and clarifying nature of taxes disputes and legal nature of taxes decisions this for the student of higher studies to cover in depth development in taxes legislation and the study to be comparative and in depth.
